### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**Players must have registered with their home association before they can register for Gloucester/Orleans Blues.**

Typically in the week before Labour Day, there will be a player and parent information night. This allows opportunity to meet the coach, hear their plans & philosophies for the season, come to understand the strategy & schedule for tryouts, and follows with a question and answer period. Tryouts typically start on Labour Day weekend and run for about 10 days. The age groupings and Rep B registration fees for the 2010/2011 hockey season are:

All Players, including goaltenders, must supply and wear full hockey equipment and be at the arena 30 minutes prior to the scheduled ice session to allow time for sweater pick-up.
